

MESSA coverage of breast pumps

All MESSA plans cover one breast pump per birth. You may choose an electric or manual pump – you can either obtain one at no cost to you from a qualified durable medical equipment supplier or purchase one from a retail outlet such as Babies “R” Us, Meijer or Rite-Aid.

If you go to a qualified durable medical equipment supplier:

- You will need a prescription for a breast pump from your physician.
- Ask which breast pump options are available at no charge to you. Certain pumps are covered 100 percent with no out-of-pocket cost.
- For your convenience, the supplier will bill MESSA.

If you go to a store:

- You will need a prescription for a breast pump from your physician.
- You will need to pay up front for the breast pump and then get reimbursed from MESSA up to \$300. If the device you choose costs more than \$300, you will need to pay the excess amount. Sales tax and/or shipping charges are not reimbursable.
